

## FINE ART PRINT BURSARY FOR THOSE WHO HAVE EXPERIENCED DISPLACEMENT

Weekend Etching course 29-30 October, 2023 at Graphic Studio Dublin DIGITAL SUBMISSION ONLY

## A 2-day workshop offered to 4 artists who have experienced displacement. As part of an ongoing commitment to artists, Graphic Studio Dublin, in line with its EDI policies, are offering 4 artists who have first-hand experience of displacement, access to a weekend workshop- an Introduction to Intaglio / Etching. It is planned that the two-day course will take place on Sunday 29 & Monday 30 October 2023. There will be no charge for this course, however we do ask for an indication of country of origin and how long you have been in Ireland. Artists can be at any stage of their careers, in any discipline, who are interested in exploring print processes. No printmaking experience is necessary. The workshop will provide an ideal environment for the development of a creative project in printmaking and an opportunity to network with other artists.

This course will be taught by Vaida Varnagiene, a printmaker and member of Graphic Studio Dublin. The course will be taught through English, but Vaida is also proficient in Russian.

## An introduction to Intaglio Etching

This course is designed for artists who may be new to printmaking but are interested in the techniques. Using a pre-pared image as a starting point – size 15 x 18cm, students will apply a hard ground to a copperplate, drawing lines in the wax and then etching this in acid. A fine aquatint will then be applied allowing the creation of a number of tones on the plate. Inking up and printing on a traditional printing press will follow and students may produce a small edition of their works.
